Get Ready

When you feel ready to get started, gather these documents to help make the application process easier.



BASIC INFORMATION

Names and dates of birth for each person in your household



HOME MAILING ADDRESS

If someone in your household (those you include on your tax returns) has a different home address, you will need to add that too.



SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS

(IF APPLICABLE)

If someone in your household (those you include on your tax returns) has a different home address, you will need to add that too.



IMMIGRATION DOCUMENT INFORMATION (IF APPLICABLE)

Is anyone on your application a legal immigrant? If so, you'll be requested to provide information from your immigration documents.



INCOME INFORMATION

You will need to enter your estimated 2022 income for everyone in your household, including standard deductions from your yearly tax returns.



TAX FILING INFORMATION

If you file federal income taxes, you may be asked about your filing status and whom you claim as a dependent on your taxes.

Apply for Coverage

Once you've gathered the information you need to apply, you can create an account and complete your application. If you already had an account on Healthcare.gov, make sure you use the same primary account-holder information when creating your account on CoverME.gov to ensure your account is matched to your existing application information.

Shop for a Plan

Select "Shop for Plans" to review plans and choose the one that works best for you and your family.

Pay Your First Month's Premium

For coverage to start, you must pay your first month's premium to your health insurance company before the policy effective date (ex. Jan. 1, 2022). CoverME.gov allows consumers to pay their first month's premium online through the "Pay Now" function.
