# MaineCare— now for pregnant people and children under 21, with or without proof of citizenship.

## **What is MaineCare?**

MaineCare is the State's Medicaid program. MaineCare provides free and low-cost health insurance to people who meet eligibility guidelines, including household income. MaineCare covers doctor visits, prescription drugs, emergency care, substance use disorder treatment, and more.

## **I live in Maine but don't have documentation. Can my children get MaineCare?**

Yes. If you meet MaineCare eligibility guidelines, MaineCare is now offered to pregnant people, children, and young adults under 21, with or without proof of citizenship.

## **Will the information I share with MaineCare be given to other government agencies?**

The Maine Department of Health and Human Services does not share information about the immigration status of applicants who are living in the U.S. without documentation with outside government agencies. Our only goal is to help people living in Maine get access to medical care.

## **I am 20 and live on my own. Can I get MaineCare?**

Yes. If you are under 21 and meet eligibility guidelines for MaineCare, you can get covered whether or not you are living on your own.

## **I am pregnant. Can I get MaineCare?**

Yes, if you meet the eligibility guidelines. If you do not have proof of citizenship, you will be covered for 12 months after your pregnancy ends. Your baby will continue to receive MaineCare for as long as they meet the MaineCare eligibility guidelines for children.
