

WOMEN'S HEALTH: COVERED BENEFITS

All health insurance plans on CoverME.gov offer pre-deductible coverage, including many reproductive and maternal health services. Some services are completely free and others require some out-of-pocket costs, even if you have not met your deductible. **Services generally must be performed by an in-network healthcare provider.** Cost may vary in some cases depending on risk or health status.

PREVENTIVE HEALTH SERVICES, INCLUDING:

- Annual exams with a primary care provider*
- Well women's exams with a specialist (eg. OB/GYN)*
- Tobacco intervention and counseling*
- Urinary tract or other infection screening*
- Diagnostic breast exam*
- Breast cancer genetic test for higher risk women*
- Breast cancer screening for women 40 years and up*
- Immunizations*
- STI screenings*
- Breast cancer chemoprevention
- Cervical cancer screening*
- Diabetes screening*
- Domestic and interpersonal violence screening and counseling*

FAMILY PLANNING, PREGNANCY, AND POSTPARTUM SERVICES, INCLUDING:

- Prescription birth control and other contraceptives*
- Breastfeeding support and counseling*
- Folic acid supplements*
- Gestational diabetes screening*
- Maternal depression screenings at well-baby visits*
- Preeclampsia prevention and screening*
- Rhesus incompatibility screening*
- Donor breastmilk
- Fertility care
- Expanded postpartum care
- Certified midwives
- Abortion services

MEDICATIONS AND TREATMENTS, INCLUDING:

- Medications:
 - All prescription contraceptives*
 - Over-the-counter oral contraceptives
 - PrEP HIV prevention medication*
 - HIV Prevention Drugs
- Treatments:
 - Symptomatic varicose vein surgery
 - Breast reduction surgery
