

Need Health Insurance? Visit CoverME.gov today!

If you are a seasonal worker in Maine with an H2-A or H2-B Visa, you could qualify for health insurance through CoverME.gov.

CoverME.gov is where eligible Maine residents can apply for financial assistance and purchase quality, affordable health insurance. Marketplace health plans on CoverME.gov offer a full set of health benefits, and CoverME.gov is the only place to access financial assistance to help lower the cost of monthly premiums. Many Maine residents can find coverage for as little as a few dollars a month.

You will have 60 days to apply and enroll in health insurance through a Special Enrollment Period once you receive a visa, or you can enroll during the annual Open Enrollment Period from November 1 through January 15.

Immigration and CoverME.gov:

- Applying for health insurance through CoverME.gov will not affect your chances of becoming a Lawful Permanent Resident of the United States.
- Documentation of citizenship or immigration status is only necessary for the people applying for coverage, not for other members of the household.
- Information consumers provide will not be used by government agencies to enforce immigration laws or policies.
