

INTRODUCTION

November 1, 2022 marks the beginning of the second Open Enrollment Period for **CoverME.gov** — Maine's official Health Insurance Marketplace. This year, financial assistance to make coverage affordable will be available to more Mainers than ever. Thanks to a new federal rule change that addresses what is referred to as the "Family Glitch", more family members of employees who get insurance through their employer will be eligible to receive financial assistance for quality health insurance through **CoverME.gov**. This rule change, as well as a three-year extension by Congress to the increased financial assistance first provided in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, makes finding affordable health insurance through **CoverME.gov** easier than ever before.

Partners across the state are continuing the important work of connecting consumers with free local assistance to get Maine residents enrolled for 2023. Last year, 66,095 Mainers selected plans through **CoverME.gov**, representing a 10% increase from 2021. This year we want to reach new audiences and encourage even more Maine residents to get covered and protect their household with the security insurance offers! Thank you for your valued partnership as we continue to **help consumers access affordable**, **quality health coverage**.



COVERME.GOV HIGHLIGHTS


- Open Enrollment runs from **November 1, 2022 through January 15, 2023**. Consumers should choose a plan by December 15, 2022 for insurance that starts on January 1, 2023. Consumers who enroll between December 16, 2022 and January 15, 2023 will have coverage starting on February 1.
- All health plans offered on **CoverME.gov** provide quality, comprehensive coverage that includes Essential Health Benefits, including hospitalization, prescription drugs, mental health and substance use treatment, and more.
- **CoverME.gov** is the **only place** for Maine people to access financial assistance to lower their premiums and out-of-pocket costs.
- More Maine people than ever qualify for financial assistance this year, making it easier to find the health insurance plan that best fits their needs and budget for 2023. This includes:
 - People who earn more than 400% of the federal poverty level (about \$54,000 for an individual, or \$111,000 for a family of four) who can now qualify for financial help if coverage would otherwise be unaffordable to them.
 - People who previously were ineligible because a member of their family has an offer of affordable coverage through a job.








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


