HOW TO ASSIGN AN EXPERT

Professionals are available statewide to assist you in exploring your coverage options. Their support is completely free to you. They'll make sure you have all the information to choose confidently.

If you want to get help from a broker or Maine Enrollment Assister, you will need to assign an expert in your CoverME.gov account so they can access your information. Here are the steps to take **after you have set up your**CoverME.gov account:


Step 1: Go to CoverME.gov and sign in to your account.




Step 2: From the home page of your account, click the button 'Assign an Expert.'




Step 3: Instructions to find a broker or Maine Enrollment Assister will pop up. If you do not have an expert already, find one near you by visiting CoverME.gov/localhelp. Click the 'Assign an Expert' button to continue.



Step 4: For brokers, you can search by their name or their agency's name and hit 'Select.' For Maine Enrollment Assisters, you need to search by the name of their organization.




Step 5: The next screen will show the name of the expert you selected, their contact information, and details about their organization. Click the 'Select this Expert' button.



Please note: if you already have an expert designated on your account, they will no longer have access to your account.

Step 6: After you have selected your expert, access their information through the menu on the left side of the screen.
